

## FISCAL SPONSORSHIP FAQ

### ***Why should a filmmaker work with a fiscal sponsor?***

Fiscal sponsors allow you to establish a fiduciary relationship with a non-profit organization. This allows your donations to be tax-exempt because the donations are directed to the non-profit organization. These funds are then passed on to the filmmaker/fiscal sponsee less fees. You get the advantage of soliciting tax-exempt donations without having to create your own non-profit!

Fiscal sponsorship can be an important factor for soliciting donations from individuals, foundations, and other grant sources. Some grant applications require a fiscal sponsor so the grantmaker can administer funds to a non-profit organization.

### ***What is the benefit for a donor?***

Donations to a fiscal sponsor are tax deductible as allowed by federal and state regulations.

### ***How can someone make a donation?***

We accept donations by credit card on our website through individual project pages. Donations can also be made via check or direct deposit.

### ***What are the fees for fiscal sponsorship?***

We have a sliding scale of fees between 4% to 7% depending upon the donation amount.

- 7% for unique donations up to \$4,999.
- 6% for unique donations between \$5,000 and \$9,999.
- 5% for unique donations between \$10,000 and \$49,999.
- 4% for unique donations of \$50,000 and greater.
- 7% for funds through government agencies, including NEA, NEH, CCH and other federal, state, and regional government funding sources. Additional fees for government grants may apply.
- 10% for unique donations less than \$70 that require an individual distribution.

### ***Does a fiscal sponsor have control over my project?***

All creative control lies with the filmmaker. However, we do monitor project progress and help ensure that funds are being spent in accordance with any funder requirements.

### ***Why should I choose Filmmakers Collaborative SF as my fiscal sponsor?***

We are experienced filmmakers and understand the challenges of getting a film made! We see ourselves as partners with our filmmakers, and we do our best to support them in the filmmaking process. In addition to fiscal sponsorship, we provide advice about fundraising and distribution, feedback on proposals, rough cut reviews, and low cost consulting.
